#### Managing Faxes Needing Provider Signature in the Outpatient Setting

#### For Providers - get this ready first:

- 1) Load Adobe DC (free) on local machine https://get.adobe.com/reader/
- 2) Ensure your CU OneDrive is loaded on your local machine



#### Provider Workflow:

- 1) You will receive email with an attached PDF document that needs your signature.
- Save PDF document from email to your CU Anschutz OneDrive (step 2, above). This is HIPAA secure. Suggested folder name: "Clinical Inbox Documents"

3) Open the PDF with Adobe DC (step 1, above).

4) Use Fill & Sign (on the right-hand side) – don't use Edit PDF!





- 5) Save file back to CU Anschutz OneDrive folder.
- 6) Email to front desk staff for re-faxing and import into Epic. If this document also needs to be entered for Health Maintenance, cc. your Medical Assistant on the email. Your clinic manager will send you the correct staff email addresses.




Family Medicine United for Colorado is a collaborative volunteer community of solutions organized around the principle of collective action in response to Colorado's growing primary care crisis.

- This represents an intolerable threat to the physical, mental and fiscal health and wellbeing of Coloradans, their communities, and the state.












Our mission is to preserve and advance Family Medicine during and after the COVID-19 pandemic.


