MVFP works closely with CU Family Medicine and other entities to pursue continued improvement for primary care. We strive to be at the forefront of change. Our goal is to provide quality primary care that encompasses building community within our office, within the Roaring Fork Valley, and beyond.

In addition, we have a nonprofit arm, Healthy All Together (HAT) with the mission of connecting community and creating leadership around health. HAT provides us a different venue to work **hand in hand** with our community to meet the health, social, and economic needs of our populace. We have an **in house** food bank, connect people to rental assistance resources, and collaborate with other non-profit organizations to problem-solve the financial challenges of health services. We are currently pursuing a partnership with local at risk communities to develop innovative health / community wellness plans.

MidValley Family Practice aims to continue to innovate ways to provide access to inclusive and holistic care in our area with the goal of building health equity and community. Over the past two years alone our small rural private practice has received nearly \$1,000,000 in grants to look at substance abuse in our community, treat the underinsured through the COVID pandemic, create a green food bank, help develop a vulnerability index through our EHR, and are continually exploring other ways to serve the local community.
