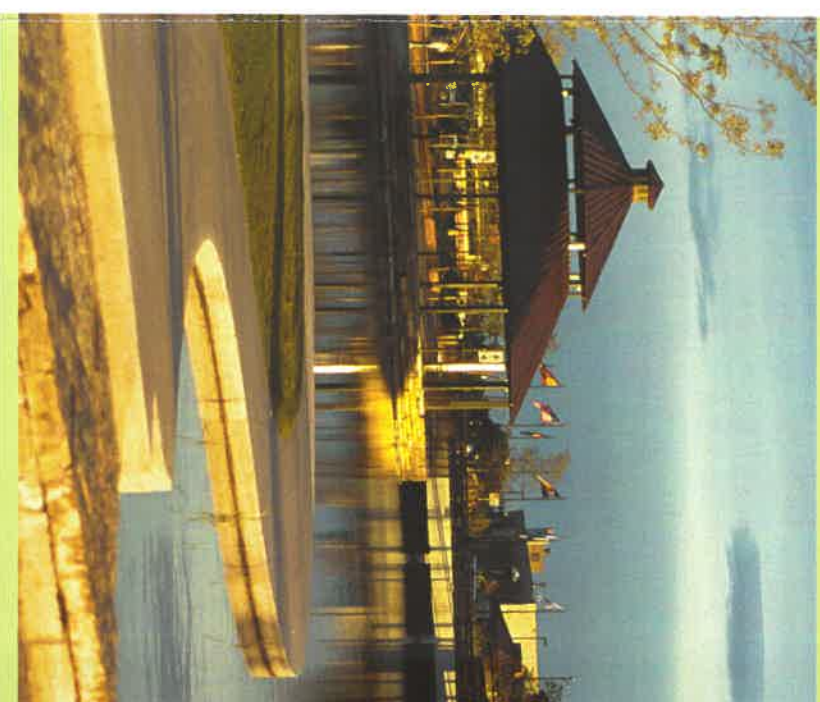

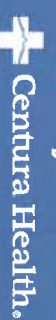

Our program focuses on the increasingly complex biomedical skills needed by family physicians, with attention to the many psychological, social, and systems issues that affect health, illness, and healing. The core of any residency program is its faculty. Balancing Work and Play

Pueblo is located in southeastern Colorado and is the most populous city of Pueblo County with roughly 150,000 people. Located between rivers and mountains, the climate is enjoyable year-round with outdoor activities available for every season in which to indulge.

We're home to miles of biking trails. Lake Pueblo State Park and the Arkansas River which provides water enthusiasts with ample boating, jet skiing, tubing, kayaking, paddle boarding and fishing opportunities. The Historic Arkansas River Walk and Union Avenue Historic District includes a scenic walkway, outdoor amphitheater, great shops and restaurants, and art created by local, regional and nationally recognized artists. There is outdoor entertainment every Friday and Saturday night from May to September. Camping, hiking, world-class skiing and other mountain activities are as close as 40 minutes away.
