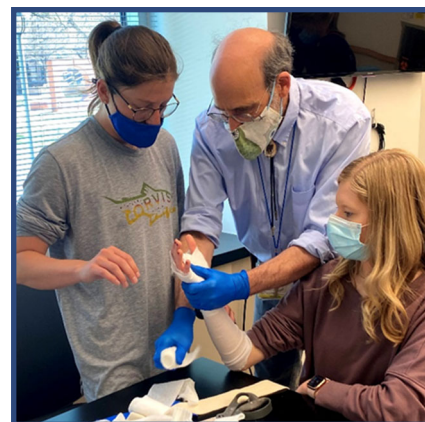
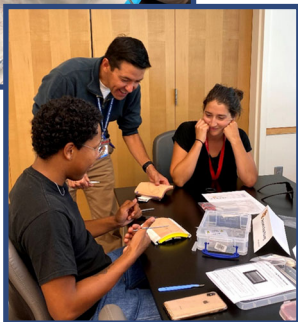


Prepare the next generation of rural physicians
