Coupled with the high cost of living, one of the highest costs of healthcare in the nation, this makes for a dichotomous community of visitors/part time residents and workforce.
Granby/Kremmling	12	January-December	Each month the resident will have a mix of 13-17 ER, Urgent Care, and clinic shifts (8-12 hours), depending on resident and attending interest; and four to five 24 hour ER shifts per month. Clinical experiences will be at the Kremmling Memorial Hospital in Kremmling, CO and Middle Park Medical Center in Granby, CO. Optional sites include a rural outreach clinic in Walden, CO and the Middle Park Medical Center Urgent Care in the town of Winter Park, CO.	The goal of this rotation is to focus resident training in emergency/urgent care in a rural area; however, the resident will be able to work with the preceptor to create a custom rural medicine experience. Clinic is adjacent to the hospital 10 exam rooms. EHR is Epic. Will involve limited inpatient care – the hospital census is typically 2-3 patients. Granby – opportunities include outpatient care (higher volume than Kremmling), some inpatient, and busier ER. Clinic is located within a new medical center that offers surgery and ER/trauma care; they also have two inpatient beds that are an extension of the critical access hospital in Kremmling. With a brand new facility, including dedicated resident living quarters, in house retail pharmacy, 16 visiting subspecialties, and full spectrum of Rural Health Clinic, ER, Surgery and inpatient experience, you will find that your skills will be tested on a daily basis. MMH is embarking on a new accountable care organization that will focus on chronic disease management, transitions of care, population health and ensuring 100% medicare annual wellness visits are achieved.	Full spectrum work will be expected in Family Practice Clinic, ER, and IP units.	Holyoke is in the heart of one of the most successful agriculture areas in the state of Colorado. The town itself is home to 2350 people, with a very vibrant local economy, low un-employment, crime and high local support and pride. This shows in the community donating \$1.5 million to the hospital foundation over 6 years. There is a 41% Hispanic/Latin/Mexican population primarily working for Seaboard Foods. MMH is focusing on ensuring the cultural divides are broken, and all patients have access to the healthcare they need.
Julesburg	11	Varies	Julesburg has a unique setting for working with two physicians providing comprehensive medical care for our county and several surrounding Colorado and Nebraska communities. We are the providers/medical directors for the adjacent nursing home and SCLF. Both preceptors have a strong interest in teaching. We are currently involved in the UC Summer Family Medicine Clerkship and the UC CHA/PA internship rotations. We find that teaching not only fulfills a source of "giving-back" and assisting those learning in our specialty, but is also rewarding and develops our clinical skills. Finally, we hope that we will encourage residents to consider rural medicine an attractive option, not only in our community, but in countless others. We have discovered that rural family medicine requires unique skills not always appreciated or developed in urban settings and hope to share these with learning residents. Population is approximately 1,245. The town is located on the north side of the South Platte River. It is the northernmost town in the state, located less than a mile south of the Nebraska border.

We work at several local nursing homes providing geriatric care as well as the local hospital providing inpatient medicine, pediatrics and obstetric care. Valley-Wide has a busy full-spectrum rural family medicine clinic and urgent care walk-in clinic. We have multiple family medicine physicians, a pediatrician and many midlevel providers. We care for all of our own patients when admitted to the local 25-bed critical access hospital including ICU, pediatrics & adult medicine, as well as deliver all of the obstetric patients (including c-sections).	On the southeastern plains of Colorado, the town of La Junta is a welcome sight to travelers who have crossed the vast Great Plains. Approximate population is 9,000. The most famous local attraction is Brent's Old Fort National Historic Site, about nine miles from town. The fort was originally erected in the 1830s by two brothers, Charles and William Bent, and was the only permanent structure for hundreds of miles around. Kit Carson hunted for food for the fort, and other famous Western characters appear in its history. The remnants of the fort were studied and, during the nation's bicentennial, the National Park Service re-created the adobe structure as close to its original condition as possible. A living program further enhances a visit here.

We have a busy full-spectrum rural family medicine clinic with nearly 10,000 active patients with 4 doctors and 2 physician assistants. We care for all of our own patients when admitted to the 25 bed critical access hospital here, as well as deliver all of our own OBs (including c-sections).	Residents should prepare to see patients across the spectrum of age, ailment, and setting with as much independence as they are comfortable with.	Salida started as a railroad town providing a connection between the mining areas all along the Arkansas river watershed and the large East-West shipping route of the Denver Rio Grande Railroad. While there has not been a train running through Salida for over 30 years it is experiencing a second population boom in the form of recreation and art. We are in prime location for world-class mountain biking, river sports, and just a short jaunt to excellent skiing and hiking. Salida is the only rural town to get a Creative District designation by the state of Colorado and gets funding to support local arts and culture with this program. Our population is therefore split between the younger artist and recreation crowd and the older retirees, ranchers, and railroad folk.
